

CROSS COUNTRY RADIO SCRIPT

GROUND

"Bismarck Ground, Cessna 1664V on the GA ramp ready to taxi for a (say direction) departure. We have information _____. Requesting traffic advisories."

Write down taxi instruction and transponder code.

"Taxi to (runway) via (taxi route), squawk (repeat transponder code), 1664V"

TOWER

"Bismarck Tower, Cessna 1664V is at (say location) ready for takeoff."

"Fly (say assigned direction after takeoff), cleared for runway (say runway), _____"

DEPARTURE

Contact departure when instructed to by tower.

"Bismarck Departure, Cessna 1664V climbing through (say altitude), for (say cruise altitude)."

After you're on course and a safe distance from the airport:

"Departure, _____ requesting a temporary frequency change."

FLIGHT SERVICE STATION

"Grand Forks Radio, this is N1664V transmitting and receiving on (say frequency)."

After they respond:

"N1664V, please open my flight plan from (say departure airport) to (say destination airport). My time off was (say takeoff time)."

DEPARTURE

"Bismarck Departure, Cessna 1664V is back with you."

When leaving Bismarck airspace departure will say, "Cessna 1664V you're leaving my airspace, radar services terminated, squawk VFR, frequency change approved."

"Squawk VFR, frequency change approved 1664V."

Put 1200 in transponder and change to an appropriate frequency.

FLIGHT SERVICE STATION

Once established on the next leg and safe distance from airport:

"Grand Forks Radio, this is N1664V transmitting and receiving on (say frequency)."

After they respond:

"N1664V, please close my flight plan from (say departure airport) to (say destination airport) and open my flight plan from (say departure airport) to (say destination airport). My time off was (say takeoff time)."

After conversation is complete, change to an appropriate frequency.
